REPRESENTATION OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AT THE XVII PAN AMERICAN SANITARY CONFERENCE, XVIII MEETING OF THE REGIONAL COMMITTEE OF WHO FOR THE AMERICAS

The XVI Meeting of the Directing Council held in Washington, D. C. from 27 September to 8 October 1965, approved the following

RESOLUTION XXIII

"THE DIRECTING COUNCIL,

Having considered Resolution VIII of the 52nd Meeting of the Executive Committee concerning the organization of the Pan American Sanitary Conference;

Having considered the report of the Working Party of the Executive Committee in the Addendum to Official Document No. 62, which recommends 'That the Executive Committee be officially represented at the meetings of the Directing Council and the Conference by its Chairman or any other member the Committee may designate; and

Bearing in mind the desirability of the Executive Committee being officially represented at those meetings,

RESOLVES:

l. To provide that the Executive Committee shall be officially represented by its Chairman or any other member designated by the Committee at the meetings of the Directing Council of the Pan American Health Organization and of the Pan American Sanitary Conference.

2. To provide that the travel and subsistence expenses of the official representative of the Executive Committee at the meeting shall be borne by the Organization."

It is therefore incumbent upon the Executive Committee, at this meeting, to designate a person to officially represent it at the XVII Pan American Sanitary Conference.
