**PROPOSED PROGRAM AND BUDGET ESTIMATES OF THE WHO  
FOR THE REGION OF THE AMERICAS, 1974**

*THE 21<sup>st</sup> DIRECTING COUNCIL,*

Having considered Official Document 114, submitted by the Director of the Pan American Sanitary Bureau, which contains the proposed program and budget estimates of the World Health Organization for the Region of the Americas for 1974;

Bearing in mind that the proposed program and budget estimates are submitted to the Directing Council as Regional Committee of the World Health Organization for the Americas, for review and transmittal to the Director-General of that Organization so that he may take them into account when preparing the proposed budget estimates of WHO for 1974; and

Noting the recommendations made by the 68th Meeting of the Executive Committee,

***RESOLVES***

1. To approve the proposed program and budget estimates of the World Health Organization for the Region of the Americas for 1974, appearing in Official Document 114, and to request the Regional

Director to transmit them to the Director-General of that Organization so that he may take them into account in preparing the WHO budget estimates for 1974.

2. To request the Director-General that, when preparing those proposed budget estimates, he give favorable consideration to increasing the proportion assigned to the Region of the Americas.
