THE 10th DIRECTING COUNCIL,

Having examined the report on sanitary regulations for hotels and restaurants (Document CD10/12), 1 which contains an account of the activities reported by the Technical Committee of Experts; and Considering the terms of Resolution XVI adopted by the Directing Council at its IX Meeting,

RESOLVES

- 1. To take note of the report presented, and to request the Director to inform the Technical Committee of Experts of the observations made by the Directing Council.
- 2. To request the Director to inform the Governing Bodies, in due course, of the progress of the work in connection with the preparation of a manual containing minimum sanitation standards to be recommended for application in hotels, restaurants, transportation facilities, and tourist centers.
