1. APPROVAL OF THE FINAL REPORT (Document CE14/20 Rev. 1).

The Chairman stated that the provisional text of the Final Report contained the resolutions adopted at the Fifth Plenary Session, and inquired whether there were any modifications to be made.

The Representative of El Salvador suggested that a more adequate wording be given to the third and fourth paragraphs of the preamble of Resolution XI (Revision of the Pan American Sanitary Code in accordance with the International Sanitary Regulations).

The Chairman stated that the English text of these clauses appeared to be satisfactory and that the Spanish text should be modified in order to reconcile it to the English wording.

DECISION TAKEN

It was decided to approve the text of the Final Report, and to request the Secretariat to make the necessary drafting changes in accordance with the observations made.

The Chairman announced that he would call the Representatives to sign the Final Report sometime during the period of the Directing Council meetings.
