ASPECTS OF HEALTH RELATED TO POPULATION DYNAMICS

THE 16th DIRECTING COUNCIL,

Having considered Resolution WHA18.49 of the Eighteenth World Health Assembly; Considering Resolution XXXI of the XV Meeting of the Directing Council, XVI Meeting of the Regional Committee of WHO, which recommended various studies on population dynamics; and Recognizing the interrelationships and interactions of health, population growth, and socioeconomic development, and the importance of active programs of cooperation among organizations of the Inter-American System,

RESOLVES

To request the Director:

- 1.To provide technical advice, as requested, on the health aspects of population dynamics, in line with Resolution WHA18.49 adopted by the Eighteenth World Health Assembly.
- 2.To cooperate with the Inter-American Committee on the Alliance for Progress in studies assigned to it by Section 1, paragraph 16, of the progress report on the Alliance (adopted at the Third Annual

Meeting of [the Inter-American Economic and Social Council] at the Ministerial Level, 9 December 1964).

3.To conduct studies as may be desirable on population dynamics related to the program activities of PAHO, and to support professional training as appropriate.
