DOCUMENTS OF THE MEETING

In order to facilitate the study and consultation of the documents of the 16th Meeting of the Executive Committee, the Secretariat has prepared end distributed three volumes:

Volume I: Contains the working documents on the items of the Agenda submitted to the Executive Committee by the Director of the Pan American Sanitary Bureau.

The resolutions will be incorporated in the Final Report to be signed at the closing session of the Meeting and distributed later to all participants and Member Governments of the Organization.

Volume III: This volume contains the Final Report and Minutes of the V Meeting of the Directing Council and the 14th and 15th Meetings of the Executive Committee (Washington, D.C., September-October 1951).
