Having seen the report on the evaluation of the Latin American Center for Perinatology and Human Development (CLAP) (Document CD28/30);

Considering the provisions of Resolutions XXXI of the XX Pan American Sanitary Conference and XXXI of the XXVI Meeting of the Directing Council and, the recommendations of the 86th Meeting of the Executive Committee;1

Mindful that the Agreement between the Government of Uruguay and the Pan American Health Organization remains in effect until 31 December 1982; and

Considering the growing importance being given to perinatal care in the countries of the Region,

## **RESOLVES**

1. To take note of the report on the evaluation of the Latin American Center for Perinatology and Human Development and to thank the Director for it.

- 2. To recommend to the Director that the Organization maintain and increase its activities in connection with perinatal health and that it structure a regional perinatology program in accordance with the Regional Plan of Action
- 3. To recommend to the Director that the present structure and functions of the Center be continued until the end of 1982.
- 4. To request that the Director form a group in 1982 with the Government of Uruguay as a member, which will draw up the next agreement and establish the future structure and functions of the Center.
- 5. To request that the Director promote a network of collaborating centers for perinatal health in different countries of the Region.
