**ADMISSION OF ST. VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES IN THE
PAHO**

THE 28th DIRECTING COUNCIL,

Having examined the formal request for membership in the Pan American Health Organization made on behalf of the Government of St. Vincent and the Grenadines by the Minister of Foreign Affairs in a communication dated 12 May 1981; and

Considering that the Government of St. Vincent and the Grenadines has declared its readiness to accept all the obligations established in the Constitution of the Pan American Health Organization, to comply with the provisions of the Pan American Sanitary Code, as amended by the Additional Protocol of 24 September 1952, and to contribute by means of a specified quota assessment to the financial support of the Organization,

RESOLVES:

1. To approve with satisfaction the request of the Government of St. Vincent and the Grenadines for membership in the Pan American Health Organization.
2. To instruct the Director to transmit this decision to the Member Governments of the Organization.
