# EVALUATION OF THE TEN-YEAR HEALTH PLAN FOR THE AMERICAS

## THE 24<sup>th</sup> DIRECTING COUNCIL,

Having examined the Director's report on the evaluation of the initial phase of the Ten-Year Health Plan for the Americas (Document CD24/18);

Recognizing the great efforts made by the Governments and the positive results achieved in some areas, as evidenced by the preliminary evaluation in question;

Considering that in some program areas and in a number of countries, intensified action and increased investments are necessary if the goals of the decade are to be attained; and

Considering that the evaluation processes should be continuous and should facilitate timely decision-making so as to enable the goals to be attained within the prescribed time-limits,

#### **RESOLVES**

1. To congratulate the Director on the formulation and preparation of the report on evaluation of the initial phase of the Ten-Year Plan (Document CD24/18).

- 2. To congratulate the countries on the efforts made in common.
- 3. To urge the Governments to intensify and speed up their activities in light of the results achieved during the preliminary evaluation.
- 4. To suggest that the final evaluation of the Ten-Year Health Plan be carried out in 1980.
- 5. To request the Governments to provide PAHO, when possible, with all the information and cooperation required for achieving these purposes.
- 6. To request the Director to inform the Governing Bodies concerning the progress made in this direction.
