## INTENSIFICATION OF HEALTH PROGRAMS REPORT ON THE SPECIAL MEETING OF MINISTERS OF HEALTH

THE 18th DIRECTING COUNCIL,

Having considered the Final Report1 of the Special Meeting of Ministers of Health of the Americas, which was held in Buenos Aires, Argentina, from 14 to 19 October 1968, pursuant to Resolution XXXVII of the XVII Meeting of the Directing Council; and

Bearing in mind that the report contains a broad picture of present and future health problems and their relation to the economic and social development of the Hemisphere and indicates the general lines of a program for solving them,

## RESOLVES

- 1. To incorporate into the general policy of the Pan American Health Organization all the recommendations emanating from the Special Meeting of Ministers of Health of the Americas.
- 2. To recommend that the Director of the Pan American Sanitary Bureau analyze the recommendations formulated by the Ministers of Health of the Americas and that he submit the conclusions reached to the Governing Bodies of the Organization.
