**REPORT OF THE PAHO ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON MEDICAL
RESEARCH**

THE 28th DIRECTING COUNCIL,

Having examined the report of the PAHO Advisory Committee on Medical Research for 1980–81 (Document CD28/13);

Taking note of the emphasis being placed on stimulating and promoting research in such areas as diarrheal diseases, nutrition, health services research, socioepidemiological research, mental health, and acute respiratory diseases; and

Being aware that these subjects represent priority health problems for the Member Countries.

RESOLVES

1. To commend the PAHO Advisory Committee on Medical Research for its efforts in advising the Director on some of the important research problems to be addressed and ways of solving them.
2. To commend the Director for having initiated those activities necessary for the implementation of the recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Medical Research.
