**ELECTION OF THREE MEMBER STATES TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE
ON THE EXPIRATION OF THE PERIODS OF OFFICE
OF EL SALVADOR, JAMAICA, AND URUGUAY**

THE 44th DIRECTING COUNCIL,

Bearing in mind the provision of Articles 4.D and 15.A of the Constitution of the Pan American Health Organization; and

Considering that Argentina, Barbados, and Costa Rica were elected to serve on the Executive Committee upon the expiration of the periods of El Salvador, Jamaica, and Uruguay.

RESOLVES:

1. To declare Argentina, Barbados, and Costa Rica elected to membership on the Executive Committee for the period of three years.
2. To thank El Salvador, Jamaica, and Uruguay for the services rendered to the Organization during the past three years by their delegates on the Executive Committee.
