OPENING OF THE MEETING

Dr. Everardo González Gálvez (Panama), in his capacity as outgoing Chairman of the Executive Committee, opened the meeting and welcomed the Representatives of Bolivia, Jamaica, and the United States of America, which were elected to the Executive Committee on the expiry of the terms of office of Barbados, Canada, and El Salvador.

AGENDA

The draft agenda contained in Document CE73/1 was adopted unanimously.

DECISIONS

1. The Committee took note of the following resolutions of the XIX Pan American Sanitary Conference of interest to it: Resolutions VIII, X, XXVI, XLIV, and XLV.

2. Bolivia was elected to serve on the Award Committee for the PAHO Award for Administration to fill the vacancy caused by the departure of El Salvador from the Executive Committee.

3. With regard to Item 7 of the Agenda on the functions of the Executive Committee, the Committee agreed with the Director's suggestion to defer consideration of the subject until the 74th Meeting in order that the Director elect might have the opportunity to analyze the documentation prepared.

4. The Committee recommended that the dates of the 74th Meeting be determined by the Director in consultation with the Chairman of the Executive Committee, bearing in mind the national holiday in the United States of America on 4 July.

5. The Committee recommended that consideration of the details of the inaugural ceremony of the new Director be delayed until after his confirmation as Regional Director of the World Health Organization by the Executive Board of WHO in January 1975.

6. The Committee requested that among the resolutions of the XIX Pan American Sanitary Conference brought to its attention be included Resolution XXXV on the designation of Dr. Abraham Horwitz as Director Emeritus of the Pan American Sanitary Bureau.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Chairman of the Executive Committee and the Director of the Pan American Sanitary Bureau, Secretary ex officio, sign the present Final Report in the English and the Spanish languages, both texts being equally authentic.
