**RESOLUTIONS OF THE 22nd WORLD HEALTH ASSEMBLY OF
INTEREST TO THE REGIONAL COMMITTEE**

THE 19th DIRECTING COUNCIL,

Having considered Document CD19/18, in which the Director of the Pan American Sanitary Bureau submitted to the Regional Committee for the Americas three resolutions of the Twenty-Second World Health Assembly; and

Seeing that the Pan American Sanitary Bureau is already concerned with the subjects referred to in these resolutions,

RESOLVES

To take note of the following resolutions of the Twenty-Second World Health Assembly contained in Document CD19/18: WHA22.34 (Smallpox Eradication Program), WHA22.39 (Re-examination of the Global Strategy of Malaria Eradication), WHA22.53 (Long-Term Planning in the Field of Health, Biennial Programming, and Improvement of the Evaluation Process).
