## Topic 32: PLACE AND DATE OF THE XVI PAN AMERICAN SANITARY CONFERENCE

In conformity with Article 7-A of the Constitution of the Pan American Sanitary Organization, "the Conference shall normally meet once in four years in the country determined by its immediately preceding meeting, on a date fixed by the Host Government after consultation with the Director. No two successive meetings of the Conference shall be held in the same country."

In accordance with the terms of Resolution IX of the XIII Pan American Sanitary Conference, the XVI Pan American Sanitary Conference is to take place in 1962.

To facilitate a decision by the Conference with respect to this topic, attached to the present document is a list of the places and dates of the previous fourteen Pan American Sanitary Conferences.

The Director is at the disposal of the delegations to answer any inquiries concerning the obligations customarily assumed by the host government, those incurred by the Pan American Sanitary Organization, and the financial implications thereof.
