Topic 27: ELECTION OF THREE MEMBER COUNTRIES TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE
ON TERMINATION OF THE PERIODS OF OFFICE OF BRAZIL, HONDURAS,
AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

Pursuant to Article 13-A of the Constitution of the Pan American Health Organization, the Executive Committee

"shall be composed of seven Member Governments elected by the Council for overlapping terms of three years... A Member Government shall not be eligible for reelection to the Executive Committee until one year has elapsed."

The following table shows the composition of the Executive Committee together with the expiration dates of the terms of the present Members:

Executive Committee	
Country	Term Expires
Argentina	September 1963
Brazil	Octubre 1961
Chile	September 1963
Colombia	September 1962
El Salvador	September 1962
Honduras	Octubre 1961
United States of America	Octubre 1961

It is incumbent upon the Directing Council, in conformity with Article 13-A of the Constitution, to elect three Member Countries to replace Brazil, Honduras, and the United States of America on the Executive Committee.
