COVID-19 – Highlights

The <u>Anguilla Office of the Governor announced</u>, that there are no active cases of Covid-19, and no further positive cases reported. As of today, the shelter in place order and restrictions on business operation and movement of persons will be removed. On 1 June, a full re-opening of schools will take place.

The <u>Uruguay National Vaccination Strategy</u> has moved into the next phase named "Pueblo a Pueblo" which is focused on immunizing small towns that are far from capitals across the country. The strategy hopes to reach more than 150,000 people who have difficulty accessing vaccines. The strategy was launched 24 May and was able to deliver 6,492 doses to 40 towns in 17 departments on the first day. Vaccines are projected to reach more than 300 towns within two to three weeks.

Based on viral genomic sequencing, on 14 December 2020, the authorities of the United Kingdom reported to WHO a SARS-CoV-2 variant known as B.1.1.7; on 18 December 2020, the authorities of the Republic of South Africa reported to WHO a SARS-CoV-2 variant known as B.1.351; and, on 13 January 2021, the authorities of Brazil reported to WHO a SARS-CoV-2 variant known as P.1. SARS-CoV-2 variants B.1.1.7, B.1.351, and P.1 are defined as Variants of Concern (VOC), together with variant B.1.617, identified in India in October 2020

Starting on 18 December 2020, WHO shared that information with authorities across the globe about SARS-CoV-2 VOCs and VOI, through dedicated channels established under the International Health Regulations (IHR), as well with the public through the WHO web site. 1,2,3

International traffic-related measures adopted by States Parties in the Americas in response to the detection of SARS-CoV-2 variants

The table below summarizes international traffic-related measures adopted by States Parties to the IHR in the Region of the Americas in response to the detection of SARS-CoV-2 variants. Measures adopted are consistent with current Temporary Recommendations, ^{4,5} issued by the Director-General of WHO in the context of the Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC), determined on 30 January 2020 according to IHR provisions.







Argentina: On 14 March 2021, due to daylight savings time observed in Eastern Standard Time zone, the Argentina data is no longer published by 3:00PM EST same day and is henceforth included in the following day table. Between 22 February and 14 March 2021, the data had corresponded to the same date.

Bahamas: According to the 27 May 2021 Bahamas Ministry of Health (MoH) publication, there are a total of 26 additional deaths under investigation, available at: https://bit.ly/3uqVMnb.

Ecuador: According to a 6 September Ecuador Ministry of Public Health press release, only cases confirmed by RT-PCR will be reported; previously, cases who tested positive by either RT-PCR or RDTs were reported, resulting in the exclusion of 8,956 cases. Available at: https://bit.ly/3h2EWEA.

Guadeloupe: Deaths are aggregated for Guadeloupe, Saint Martin and Saint Barthelemy in Santé Publique France weekly publications; death counts for Guadeloupe are calculated subtracting deaths in Saint Martin and Saint Barthelemy. Available at: https://bit.ly/39UMysd.

Puerto Rico: Aggregated case total as reported by the Puerto Rico Department of Health (DoH); 121,775 were positive by RT-PCR and 16,580 were positive by antigen tests; previously, cases who tested positive by either RT-PCR or serological RDTs were reported, resulting in the exclusion of 33,965 cases.
