## Global & Regional Update. 10 AM WDC. **05 February 2020**





#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- In the region of the Americas, Canada confirmed their fifth case of 2019-nCoV in British Colombia Province. The patient is a close contact of a previously confirmed case.
  - Samples from one (1) suspected case in Costa Rica with travel history to China including Wuhan in December has been sent for testing.
- In Japan, 10 passengers aboard the "Diamond Princess" cruise ship which has been quarantining in Yokohama since 3 February tested positive for 2019-nCoV. The ship has 1,045 crew and 2,666 passengers -- including 428 Americans -- on board and guarantine continues to be implemented.

#### **LAST 24 HOURS**

- In China, 3887 new confirmed cases (Hubei 3156), 3971 new suspected cases, 431 severe cases and 54 deaths (Hubei 65).
- Outside China: 33 confirmed cases. Japan (13), Singapore (6), Thailand (6), Republic of Korea (2), Australia (1), Malaysia (1), Philippines (1), Viet Nam (1), Belgium (1), Canada (1)

### **GLOBAL SITUATION**

- Globally 24,554 laboratory- confirmed cases of 2019-nCoV infection have been reported including 492 deaths
- 99% of confirmed cases (24,363) are in China from 31 provincial level administrative units, including Hong Kong SAR (18), Macao SAR (10), and Taiwan (11). Of those, 24,324 cases including 3,219 severe cases and were reported from Mainland China with Hubei province accounting for 68.5% of the cases and 98% (479) of the deaths.
- 490 of the 492 deaths reported to date are from Mainland China 1 death each was from Hong Kong SAR and the Philippines
- 191 confirmed cases have been reported from 24 countries outside China (see table 2). Of those, 31 cases did not have travel history to China - but are close contacts of confirmed case of 2019-nCoV or Chinese tourists of Wuhan (see table 2).

#### **PAHO/AMRO REGIONAL SITUATION**

- 1 new confirmed case was reported since yesterday in Canada British Colombia bringing the total regional confirmed cases to 16.
- One suspected case from Costa Rica with travel to Wuhan, China has been sent for testing.
- The suspected case from Ecuador was discarded after laboratory-testing negative at the U.S. CDC.
