

HIGHLIGHTS

- In the region of the Americas, the **United States** confirmed their 12th case of 2019-nCoV in Wisconsin State. The patient had travel history (TH) to Beijing China – a first in the country since the other 9 cases with TH to China were in Wuhan, the epi center of the outbreak.

Samples from one (1) suspected case in **Bolivia** with travel history to China has been sent for testing.

The 5th confirmed case from Canada reported yesterday was erroneously reported by WHO as a human-to-human transmission case. It is currently under investigation and an [erratum to the WHO Sitrep 16](#) was issued.

- In Japan, 10 additional passengers aboard the “Diamond Princess” cruise ship tested positive for 2019-nCoV bringing the total confirmed from the ship to 20 as of today.

LAST 24 HOURS

- In China**, 3697 new confirmed cases (81%, 2987 cases from Hubei). 640 severe cases and 73 deaths (Hubei (70). 5328 new suspected cases.
- Outside China**: 25 new confirmed cases: Japan (12), Republic of Korea (5), Singapore (4), Malaysia (2), Australia (1), USA (1)

GLOBAL SITUATION

- Globally 28,276 laboratory- confirmed cases of 2019-nCoV infection have been reported including 565 deaths
- 99% of total global confirmed cases (28,060) are in China from 31 provincial level administrative units, including Hong Kong SAR (21), Macao SAR (10), and Taiwan (11).
- Of the total cases in China, 28,018 cases including 3,859 severe cases and were reported from Mainland China with Hubei province accounting for 70 % of the cases and 97.5 % (549) of the deaths.
- 563 of the 565 deaths reported to date are from Mainland China – 1 death each was from Hong Kong SAR and the Philippines
- 216 confirmed cases have been reported from 24 countries outside China (see table 2). Of those, at least 35 cases did not have travel history to China - but are close contacts of confirmed case of 2019-nCoV or Chinese tourists of Wuhan (see table 2).

PAHO/AMRO REGIONAL SITUATION

- 1 new confirmed case was reported since yesterday in the United States – Wisconsin State bringing the total US case count to 12.
- 1 new suspected case from Bolivia with travel China has been sent for testing to the U.S CDC in Atlanta.
