## Global & Regional Update. 10 AM WDC. **09 February 2020**





#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- No new countries outside China reported cases of 2019-nCoV since yesterday.
- In the region of the Americas, Paraguay MoH discarded their only suspected case of 2019-nCoV in the country.
- The global number of 2019-nCoV cases and deaths now surpasses those of SARs (774 deaths due to SARS between 2002-2003)
- The third confirmed case detected in the UK in a British national, linked to a cluster in Singapore known previously for exportations at least to Malaysia and South Korea, is now linked to 5 cases in France (4 adults & 1 child) after having contact at a mountain resort while symptomatic in the Alpes (Contamines-Montjoie in Haute-Savoie). Subsequently, the child from the cluster was symptomatic while attending school – contact tracing is ongoing.

#### **LAST 24 HOURS**

- In China, 2,657 new confirmed cases (81%, 2,147 cases from Hubei). 87 severe cases and 89 deaths (Hubei (81). 3,916 new suspected cases.
- Outside China: 15 new confirmed cases: Singapore (7), France (5), Japan (1), Malaysia (1), Republic of Korea (1)

### **GLOBAL SITUATION**

- Globally 37,554 laboratory- confirmed cases of 2019-nCoV infection have been reported including 813 deaths.
- Of the total 813 deaths 1 death each was from Hong Kong SAR and the Philippines. The rest were reported from Mainland China.
- 99% of total global confirmed cases (37,251) are in China from 31 provincial level administrative units, including Hong Kong SAR (29), Macao SAR (10), and Taiwan (16).
- Of the total cases in China, 37,198 cases including 6,188 severe cases and 811 deaths were reported from Mainland China – Hubei province reported 73 % of the total cases (27,100) and 96% (780) of the deaths in Mainland China.
- 303 confirmed cases have been reported from 24 countries outside China (see table 2).

### **PAHO/AMRO REGIONAL SITUATION**

- The Paraguay MoH discarded the only suspected case of 2019-nCoV reported in the country to date.
- The Dominican Republic MoH released a press statement yesterday reporting that 5 citizens previously admitted to the hospital for surveillance tested negative. One symptomatic 35-year-old male with travel to China tested negative for all 5 respiratory viruses circulating in the country. PAHO IHR is following up with the NFP for further information and clarification.
