- On 28 June 2021, the El Salvador Ministry of Health reported the completion of the first phase of a plan to replace 50% of hospital beds across 30 health centers in the public care network of the Ministry of Health. Spotlight – Multisystem inflammatory system in children and adolescents (MIS-C):

Since the first cases of multisystem inflammatory syndrome in children and adolescents temporally related to COVID-19 (MIS-C) reported in the Region of the Americas and until 1 July 2021 10:00 EST, there remain 23 countries/territories that have officially reported to PAHO/WHO or through an official website a total of 6,184 confirmed cases of MIS-C, including 130 deaths (see Table below; updated counts are designated in red). Compared to the previous weekly update, 109 new cases (2% relative increase in confirmed cases) and no new deaths were reported. The additional cases since the previous weekly update were reported in 3 countries: **Chile** (5 confirmed cases), **Paraguay** (2 confirmed cases), and the **United States of America** (102 confirmed cases). The United States of America and Brazil account for 83% of the total confirmed cases and 78% of the total confirmed deaths officially reported within the Region of the Americas. Additionally, as of 1 July, there remain a total of 22 countries/territories that have officially reported there have been no cases detected.



Note: Data may reflect retrospective adjustments made by countries/territories.









Argentina: On 14 March 2021, due to daylight savings time observed in Eastern Standard Time zone, the Argentina data is no longer published by 3:00PM EST same day and is henceforth included in the following day table. Between 22 February and 14 March 2021, the data had corresponded to the same date.

Ecuador: According to a 6 September Ecuador Ministry of Public Health press release, only cases confirmed by RT-PCR will be reported; previously, cases who tested positive by either RT-PCR or RDTs were reported, resulting in the exclusion of 8,956 cases. Available at: <u>https://bit.ly/3h2EWEA</u>

El Salvador: Cumulative cases and deaths as published by the Government of El Salvador: <u>https://covid19.gob.sv/</u>. The government presents a retroactively adjusted epidemiological curve of daily cases on the same dashboard.
