RESOLUTIONS

CE24.R1 The Executive Committee,

Taking into account Document CSP14/89 concerning additional documentation to facilitate the analysis of budget trends,

Resolves:

To recommend that the Director of the Pan American Sanitary Bureau prepare for the next meeting of the Executive Committee, to be held in April 1955, data on the proportionate distribution of funds administered by the Bureau in its various technical and administrative activities in such manner that this analysis will show a comparison of the expenditures of the past four years with those proposed for future programs.

CE24.R2 The Executive Committee,

Taking into account Document CSP14/89 concerning measures for strengthening national public health administration,

Resolves:

To recommend that the Director include on the draft agenda of the VIII Meeting of the Directing Council the topic "Measures Designed to Strengthen National Public Health Administration."

CE24.R3 The Executive Committee,

Considering the experience acquired in implementing paragraph 2 of Resolution III approved by the Executive Committee at its 18th Meeting, held on 25 September 1952,

Resolves:

To abrogate paragraph 2 of Resolution III adopted by the Executive Committee at its 18th Meeting, and to authorize the Director to use his discretion in calling Zone Representatives for meetings of the Executive Committee.

CE24.R4 The Executive Committee,

Considering that the Government of Mexico, through its representative to the XIV Pan American Sanitary Conference, has invited the Executive Committee to hold its 25th Meeting in Mexico City,

Resolves:

1. To select Mexico City as the seat of the 25th Meeting of the Executive Committee.

2. To request the Government of Mexico and the Director of the Pan American Sanitary Bureau to set, by mutual agreement, the exact date on which the aforesaid Committee shall meet.
3. To express to the Government of Mexico its appreciation for this invitation.
