Bolivia was elected to serve on the Award Committee for the PAHO Award for Administration to fill the vacancy caused by the departure of El Salvador from the Executive Committee.

With regard to Item 7 of the Agenda on the functions of the Executive Committee, the Committee agreed with the Director's suggestion to defer consideration of the subject until the 74th Meeting in order that the Director elect might have the opportunity to analyze the documentation prepared.

The Committee recommended that the dates of the 74th Meeting be determined by the Director in consultation with the Chairman of the Executive Committee, bearing in mind the national holiday in the United States of America on 4 July.
