## DETERMINATION OF A PERMANENENT SITE FOR THE PAN AMERICAN SANITARY BUREAU

THE 3<sup>rd</sup> DIRECTING COUNCIL,

[Bearing in mind that] the Executive Committee, in its 7th and 8th Meetings, considered the need for the construction of a building in Washington to house the Pan American Sanitary Bureau; Considering that the Executive Committee, in its 8th Meeting, realizing that the determination of a permanent site for the Pan American Sanitary Bureau takes precedence over plans for construction, modified Topic IV on the tentative agenda of the Directing Council to read "Permanent Site of the Pan American Sanitary Bureau"; and

Considering that the conditions under which the Pan American Sanitary Bureau was organized 47 years ago no longer prevail,

RESOLVES

- 1. To place the question of the selection of a permanent site for the Pan American Sanitary Bureau on the agenda of the XIII Pan American Sanitary Conference, to be held at Ciudad Trujillo, Dominican Republic, in 1950, for final study and decision.
- 2. To appoint a committee to study the question thoroughly and to report thereon to the Conference.
