INTER-AMERICAN CONGRESSES OF PUBLIC HEALTH

THE 10th DIRECTING COUNCIL,

Bearing in mind the importance of scientific congresses in general and, particularly, those dealing with public health;

Considering the advisability of continuing to hold periodically public health congresses that will permit a review of the progress achieved in public health matters; and

Considering that the First Inter-American Congress of Public Health was held at Havana in October 1952, an that it is desirable to continue these congresses,

RESOLVES

- 1. To affirm the advisability of organizing Inter-American Congresses of Public Health on a periodic basis.
- 2. To recommend that the XV Pan American Sanitary Conference decide on the manner of holding, and the intervals between, such congresses.
