**MINIMUM SANITATION STANDARD FOR HOTELS,
RESTAURANTS, TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES, AND TOURIST
CENTERS**

THE 10th DIRECTING COUNCIL,

Having examined the report on sanitary regulations for hotels and restaurants (Document CD10/12),
1 which contains an account of the activities reported by the Technical Committee of Experts; and
Considering the terms of Resolution XVI adopted by the Directing Council at its IX Meeting,

RESOLVES

1. To take note of the report presented, and to request the Director to inform the Technical Committee of Experts of the observations made by the Directing Council.
2. To request the Director to inform the Governing Bodies, in due course, of the progress of the work in connection with the preparation of a manual containing minimum sanitation standards to be recommended for application in hotels, restaurants, transportation facilities, and tourist centers.
