## OPENING OF THE MEETING

In the absence of the Chairman, the Vice Chairman and the Rapporteur of the 101st Meeting, the proceedings of the 102nd Meeting were opened by the Director of the Pan American Sanitary Bureau, who welcomed the Representatives of Canada, Trinidad and Tobago, and Venezuela, elected to membership on the Committee on the expiration of the terms of office of Argentina, Bahamas, and Mexico.

#### AGENDA

The provisional agenda (Document CE102/1) was approved.

#### DECISIONS

- 1. The terms of Argentina, Bahamas and Mexico on the Committee having expired, the Executive Committee elected Canada, Uruguay and Venezuela to membership on the Subcommittee on Planning and Programming.
- 2. The terms of Argentina, Bahamas and Mexico on the Committee having expired, the Executive Committee elected Canada, Trinidad and Tobago and Venezuela to membership on the Special Subcommittee on Women, Health and Development.
- 3. The Executive Committee decided that the next meeting of the Subcommittee on Planning and Programming would be held at Headquarters on 7 and 8 December 1988.
- 4. The Executive Committee decided to include in the agenda of its 103rd Meeting, to be held in June 1989, an item on blindness prevention in the Americas.

DATES OF THE XXXIV MEETING OF THE DIRECTING COUNCIL OF PAHO, XLI MEETING OF THE REGIONAL COMMITTEE OF WHO FOR THE AMERICAS

THE 102nd MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE,

Bearing in mind Article 14.A of the Constitution of the Pan American Health Organization and Rule 1 of the Rules of Procedure of the Directing Council; and

Desirous of facilitating the preparations by the Member Governments for their participation in meetings of the Governing Bodies as as far in advance as possible,

# RESOLVES:

To authorize the Director to convoke the XXXIV Meeting of the Directing Council of PAHO, XLI Meeting of the Regional Committee of WHO for the Americas, to meet at the Headquarters building in Washington, D.C., from 25 to 30 September 1989.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Chairman of the Executive Committee and the Secretary ex officio, Director of the Pan American Sanitary Bureau, sign this Final Report in the English and Spanish languages, both texts being equally authentic.
