The provisional agenda (Document CE106/1) was approved.

DECISIONS

- 1. It was decided that the 107th Meeting of the Executive Committee would be held at Headquarters from 24 to 29 June 1991.
- 2. The term of office of Uruguay on the Executive Committee having expired, the Committee elected Cuba to membership on the Subcommittee on Planning and Programming.
- 3. The term of office of Panama on the Executive Committee having expired, the Committee elected Chile to membership on the Subcommittee on Inter-American Nongovernmental Organizations in Official Relations with PAHO.
- 4. The terms of office of El Salvador and Uruguay on the Executive Committee having expired, the Committee elected Brazil and Cuba to membership on the Special Subcommittee on Women, Health, and Development.

RESOLUTIONS

During the single plenary session, the Executive Committee adopted the following two resolutions:

RESOLUTION I CE106.R1

DATES OF THE XXXV MEETING OF THE DIRECTING COUNCIL OF PAHO, XLIII MEETING OF THE REGIONAL COMMITTEE OF WHO FOR THE AMERICAS

THE 106th MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE,

Bearing in mind Article 14.A of the Constitution of the Pan American Health Organization and Rule 1 of the Rules of Procedure of the Directing Council,

RESOLVES:

To authorize the Director to convoke the XXXV Meeting of the Directing Council of PAHO, XLIII Meeting of the Regional Committee of WHO for the Americas, to meet at the Headquarters building in Washington, D.C., from 23 to 28 September 1991.

RESOLUTION II CE106 R2

PAHO HEADQUARTERS BUILDING

THE 106th MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE,

Taking into account the information presented by the Director at the XXIII Pan American Sanitary Conference concerning the condition and the long-term adequacy of space in the present Headquarters building;

Considering that the XXIII Pan American Sanitary Conference, in Resolution CSP23.R22, has given authority to the Director in relation to alternative quarters for the Headquarters building; and

Recognizing that any new contractual arrangements for the Headquarters must not have adverse impact on the regular budget of the Organization,

RESOLVES:

- 1. To appoint Representatives of Barbados, Chile and the United States of America to constitute a Working Party to assist the Secretariat, in accordance with Resolution CSP23.R22 of the XXIII Pan American Sanitary Conference, in preparing specific detailed proposals for consideration by the Executive Committee.
- 2. To ask the Director to convene the Working Party, with supplemental advisors as necessary, as soon as practical in order to make recommendations to the 107th Meeting of the Executive Committee.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Chairman of the Executive Committee and the Secretary ex officio, Director of the Pan American Sanitary Bureau, sign this Final Report in the English and Spanish languages, both texts being equally authentic.

DONE, in Washington, D.C., United States of America, this twenty-ninth day of September, nineteen hundred and ninety. The Secretary shall deposit the original text in the archives of the Pan American Sanitary Bureau and shall send copies thereof to the Member Governments of the Organization.
