TRAINING IN PREVENTIVE ASPECTS OF PATHOLOGY

Considering that a favorable attitude toward programs of preventive medicine and public health is necessary in order to ensure the proper training of new generations of physicians; and Considering that the literature on human pathology should properly emphasize the preventive aspects of medicine,

RESOLVES

To instruct the Director of the Pan American Sanitary Bureau to arrange for the preparation and publication of textbooks on pathology in which the preventive aspects of the medical and social problems faced by most of the countries of the Americas are properly dealt with.
