Topic 6: REGIONAL PROGRAMS TO BE FINANCED WITH FUNDS OF THE UNITED NATIONS EXPANDED PROGRAM OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

As explained in the Introduction to the proposed program and budget estimates, Official Documents No. 17, the figures for PASB/WHO participation in the UN/TA funds are provisional and subject to the decision of each government on the health projects to be presented to the Technical Assistance Board. Since intercountry and interzone, i.e. "regional," projects do not fall within the request of any government, the Technical Assistance Board has indicated that such requirement may be fulfilled if such regional programs are supported by a resolution of an appropriate intergovernmental body, which in this case is the Directing Council of the PASO, Regional Committee of the WHO. A summary list of those projects will be found on page 217 of Official Documents No. 17.

The Executive Committee may wish to recommend to the Directing Council that, after reviewing the program and budget, it express its support of the regional projects under the UN Expanded Program of Technical Assistance, in a resolution along the following lines:

Proposed Resolution

RESOLVES:

- 1. To express its support of the regional projects under the United Nations Expanded Program of Technical Assistance, as set forth in Official Documents No. 17.
- 2. To recommend to the Directing Council the approval of a resolution along the following lines:

The Directing Council,

Having studied the Proposed Program and Budget of the World Health Organization for the Region of the Americas for 1958 (Official Documents No. 17); and

Having noted that the proposed program includes certain activities to be financed by the United Nations Expanded Program of Technical Assistance,

RESOLVES:

To endorse the regional projects to be financed in 1957 and/or 1958 by the United Nations Expanded Program of Technical Assistance, as shown in Official Documents No. 17 of the Pan American Sanitary Organization, for submittal to the Technical Assistance Board.
