Having examined the report of the Director on the status of malaria programs in the Americas (Document CD24/INF/1);

Bearing in mind Resolution XXIX adopted by the Executive Committee at its 76th Meeting;

Recognizing that the countries of the Region have begun to apply a flexible strategy in their antimalaria activities; and

Being conscious of the need to expand the training of personnel and to improve the utilization of the existing resources,

RESOLVES

- 1. To endorse Resolution XXIX adopted by the Executive Committee at its 76th Meeting.
- 2. To express its satisfaction that some countries of the Region have begun to apply a flexible strategy in their anti-malaria activities.
- 3. To again urge international lending agencies, in particular the Inter–American Development Bank (IDB), to give favorable consideration to requests from Governments for financing malaria programs.
