 - XIV. PAN AMERICAN HEALTH DAY. This day is celebrated on December 2 of each year. Beginning in 1950, World Health Day will be celebrated on April 7 of each year. It has been proposed that the celebration of only one Health Day be considered. (Executive Committee, Eighth Meeting).
 - XV. MISCELLANEOUS TOPICS. Additional topics proposed by the Representatives of the Member Governments on the Executive Committee and the Directing Council.
