Topic 30: ELECTION OF THREE MEMBER COUNTRIES TO FILL THE VACANCIES ON THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE CREATED BY THE TERMINATION OF THE PERIODS OF OFFICE OF BOLIVIA, CUBA, AND NICARAGUA

Pursuant to Article 13-A of the Constitution of the Pan American Sanitary Organization, the Executive Committee

"shall be composed of seven Member Governments elected by the Council for overlapping terms of three years ... A Member Government shall not be eligible for reelection to the Executive Committee until one year has elapsed."

The following chart shows the composition of the Executive Committee together with the expiration dates of the terms of the present Members:

Country	Term Expires
Bolivia	September 1958
Cuba	September 1958
Guatemala	September 1959
Mexico	September 1960
Nicaragua	September 1958
Peru	September 1959
Venezuela	September 1960

Since the terms of Bolivia, Cuba, and Nicaragua will expire immediately after the XV Conference, three Member Countries are to be elected to form part of the Executive Committee under the provisions of the Constitution.
