ELECTION OF TWO MEMBER COUNTRIES TO FILL THE VACANCIES ON THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE CREATED BY THE TERMINATION OF THE PERIODS OF OFFICE OF COLOMBIA AND EL SALVADOR

Pursuant to Article 15-A of the Constitution of the Pan American Health Organization, the Executive Committee

"shall be composed of seven Member Governments of the Organization elected by the Conference or the Council for overlapping terms of three years.... A Member Government shall not be eligible for reelection to the Executive Committee until one year has elapsed since the expiration of its term of office."

The following table shows the composition of the Executive Committee together with the expiration dates of the terms of the present Members:

Executive Committee	
Country	Term Expires
Argentina	September 1963
Chile	September 1963
Colombia	September 1962
El Salvador	September 1962
Nicaragua	September 1964
Peru	September 1964
Uruguay	September 1964

It is incumbent upon the Conference, in conformity with Article 15-A of the Constitution, to elect two Member Countries to replace Colombia and El Salvador on the Executive Committee.
