ELECTION OF TWO MEMBER GOVERNMENTS TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ON THE TERMINATION OF THE PERIODS OF OFFICE OF BRAZIL AND MEXICO

Pursuant to Article 15-A of the Constitution of the Pan American Health Organization, the Executive Committee "shall be composed of seven Member Governments of the Organization elected by the Conference or the Council for overlapping terms of three years... A Member Government shall not be eligible for reelection to the Executive Committee until one year has elapsed since the expiration of its term of office".

The following table shows the composition of the Executive Committee together with the expiration dates of the terms of the present Members:

Country	Term expires
Brazil	September 1966
Ecuador	September 1968
Guatemala	September 1968
Jamaica	September 1967
Mexico	September 1966
Panama	September 1967
Venezuela	September 1967

It is incumbent upon the Conference, in conformity with the abovementioned Article of the Constitution, to elect two Member Governments to replace Brazil and Mexico.
