PROPOSED RESOLUTION PRESENTED BY THE REPRESENTATIVE OF BRAZIL

The Directing Council,

Considering that the methods now being used to combat many diseases, whether in eradication or in control campaigns, bring to light social implications and economic repercussions that can be adequately measured;

Considering that there is no better way of obtaining funds than by having them appear as a capital investment; and

Considering that the proper presentation of requests for such investment will make it possible to observe its discernible effects on the entire national economy,

## RESOLVES:

To recommend that the Director make a study on methods of assessing the economic impact of health programs on the national economy of Member Governments.
