COVID-19 - Highlights

- Brazil: ANVISA authorized a new covid-19 vaccine clinical trial involving 30,000 volunteers. The approved clinical trial is phase 2/3, randomized, blind to observer, placebo-controlled, to assess the safety, efficacy, and immunogenicity of the vaccine in adults 18 years of age and older. - Uruguay: The President indicated that measures put in place on March 23 will be extended until April 30, including suspension of attendance in the educational system. He highlighted the need for personal protection, praised the vaccination plan and said he hopes that in May the results of vaccination campaign will be felt. - 3. **Peru:** The president of the Council of Ministers announced that the classification of the level of risk in the provinces will be done every three weeks to enable better predictability regarding the measures that have been adopted in the framework of the fight against the pandemic. Based on viral genomic sequencing, on 14 December 2020, the authorities of the United Kingdom reported to WHO a SARS-CoV-2 variant known as B.1.1.7; on 18 December 2020, the authorities of the Republic of South Africa reported to WHO a SARS-CoV-2 variant known as B.1.351; and, on 13 January 2021, the authorities of Brazil reported to WHO a SARS-CoV-2 variant known as P.1. Starting on 18 December 2020, WHO shared that information with authorities across the globe, through dedicated channels established under the International Health Regulations (IHR), as well with the public through the WHO web site. 1,2,3

The table below summarizes international traffic-related measures adopted by States Parties to the IHR in the Region of the Americas in response to the detection of SARS-CoV-2 variants. Measures adopted are consistent with current Temporary Recommendations, ^{4,5} issued by the Director-General of WHO in the context of the Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC), determined on 30 January 2020 according to IHR provisions.










Argentina: On 14 March 2021, due to daylight savings time observed in Eastern Standard Time zone, the Argentina data is no longer published by 3:00PM EST same day and is henceforth included in the following day table. Between 22 February and 14 March 2021, the data had corresponded to the same date.
