Selected Highlights

From the onset of the pandemic through June 2022

Total cases ▶ 29.9% of the global count

2,765,559
Total deaths ▶ 43.6% of the global count

Regional achievements

17 countries/territories achieved the WHO 70% vaccination target

> 707 M
people vaccinated

> 4 M complete genomic sequences from the Americas shared globally

300 Emergency Medical Teams and **385** Alternative Medical Care Sites increased medical surge capacities in 23 countries

69.2 % of the population of the Americas

> 1.9 B doses of COVID-19 vaccines administered

> 144 M doses delivered through PAHO's Revolving Fund to 33 countries and territories

31 laboratories from 28 countries participate in the COVID-19 Genomic Surveillance Regional Network (COVIGEN)

227 PPE shipments to 35 countries and territories, including: **49.5 M** surgical and respirator masks and **8.7 M** gloves

PAHO's response

> 406 regional and national trainings to strengthen response capacities

> 330 publications, including public health guidelines



> US\$ 298 M in diagnostic tests, PPE, and medicines to protect **> 39 M** people through PAHO's Strategic Fund

138 technical field missions conducted in 25 countries and territories



> 22 k professionals trained in infection prevention and control (IPC)

> 43 M COVID-19 diagnostic tests delivered to 39 countries and territories

> US\$ 442 M mobilized from strategic donors and partners.
